<u>Agenda Item #3 – Update on Executive Director Search</u>

Tommy Hamrick, Director of Civil Services with the City of Lakeland addressed the Board.

- Board will interview top five to ten candidates.

Items discussed:

Agenda Item #5 - Financial Statement

Distributed unaudited October 2010 through March 2011 Financial Statement. (Exhibit 4) Items discussed:

- Reviewed revenues and expenses.
- No Idle time for buses after 10 minutes.
- Year to date cost per hour is \$91.08; prior year cost per hour is \$91.29; projection of cost per hour for the fiscal year is \$91.45.

Agenda Item #6 - Cost Saving Options

Items discussed:

- Distributed two versions of 5-year operating plan. (Exhibit 5)
- Received notice that the Federal Operating Grant (5307) could be decreased by an estimated amount of \$600,000.
- Reviewed proposed budget cuts including cutting Saturday service, cut seven service runs, eliminate lead operator positions (employees would be retained as operators), 10 administrative staff furlough days, eliminating 2 working holidays, and adding two Federal holidays.
- Board did not support cutting Saturday service at this time.
- Staff directed to continue to work on cost saving options that were proposed at this meeting and to look into all possible options.

Agenda Item #7 - Route Restructuring

Items discussed:

- Public workshops and public hearings are set for May and June.
- Route headways will be reduced from half hour to an hour. Less need to transfer and have buses pull into the downtown terminal.
- Elimination of half of the Districts over 1000 bus stops.
- All bus stops need to be brought up to ADA compliance.

Agenda Item #8 - Reports

FDOT Report

- Safety and Maintenance audit will be conducted by the FDOT in two to three weeks. Three to four people will conduct the audit.
- Chair will meet with the Team Leader following the audit.
- Workshops are being held in September regarding grants.

PTA Update

 May 25, 2011, there will be a consolidated TPO and PTA meeting to discuss countywide transit.

Interim Executive Director Report

Received ten buses from LYNX last week.

- Six paratransit vans should be received next week.
- Charts were distributed in the packet. (Exhibit 6)
