Polk Transit Authority FY 2016-17 Proposed Budget

Revenue and Expense Summary

The proposed budget for Revenues consists of Reserves, \$1,700. The reserve balance is estimated at \$45,215 at 9/30/17.

The proposed budget for expenses for FY 2017 consists of \$1,000 for the legal fees, office/misc. expenses totaling \$700 and special service district dues \$200.

Since there are no fares or grant revenues, the budgetary activities for FY 2016 has been reduced significantly with no operational activity.

In November 2014 the My Ride referendum failed resulting in no transportation activities in FY 2014-2015 and 2016.

Audited Financials

The FYE 9-30-15 PTA financials were not audited, likewise the FYE 9-30-16 financials will not be subject to the Single Audit requirements of \$750,000 in grant expenses.
