Summary:

The below noted grants provide the funding necessary to maintain and operate the much-needed transit services

delivered to citizens of Polk County.

Under the FTA Section 5310 Grant Program the District seeks funding for the Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities. Two applications shall be submitted in the amount of \$512,500. Under each application the FTA will provide \$410,000, the FDOT will provide 51,250, and the match of \$51,250 to be provided by the District. The funding will allow for the continued operation of the Travel Trainer Program within the Lakeland urbanized area, the implementation of a Travel Trainer Program within the Winter Haven urbanized area, the purchase of Para Transit Vehicle Lifts, and Capital Preventative Maintenance.

Under the FTA Section 5311 Grant Program the District seeks funding for Capital Preventive Maintenance and Operating Assistance for rural areas of Polk County. A single application shall be submitted in the amount of \$1,697,500. Under this application the FTA will provide \$875,000 and the match of \$822,500, to be provided by the District. The funding will allow for the continued operations and capital preventive maintenance within Rural Polk County.
