Summary:

- Required Public Hearings- The Lakeland Area Mass Transit District (LAMTD) is required to conduct two public hearings on the 2017-2018 millage levy and the Fiscal Year 2017-18 budget before the millage and the budget can be finally adopted. This is the first of two hearings.
- Truth In Millage (TRIM) Notice- On July 12th, 2017 the LAMTD Board tentatively certified a .5000 proposed millage levy by a majority vote as authorized by the Florida Statue and appropriately submitted the form to the Polk County Property Appraiser's office before the required August 4, 2017 deadline.
- Millage Rate- Staff is presenting the tentative millage resolution for adoption with the .5000 millage levy.
- Percentage over Rolled-Back Rate- As required by the Florida Statues, LAMTD will need to publicly announce and advertise the percentage increase that the proposed tax rate of .5000 is above the Rolled-Back rate which is .4402. This percentage increase is 13.58%.
- Fiscal Year 2017-18 Annual Budget- The proposed budget for Fiscal Year 2017-2018 was presented to the LAMTD Board on August 9, 2017.
